Dreambox is an adaptive online math program. It is standards and curriculum aligned and designed to engage all students on their own unique learning paths.

Get the most out of DreamBox

We recommend that students complete five or more lessons per week with DreamBox Learning, at school or at home. Why? Because students who complete five lessons each week show more learning growth than peers who complete fewer lessons. To help your students reach their weekly lesson goals, we recommend setting up multiple sessions of DreamBox throughout the week and having students complete at least one or two lessons each time they log in. And remember—mistakes are OK! Your students shouldn't shy away from incorrect answers, because those wrong answers actually help DreamBox find the best lesson for each student to reinforce concepts they're struggling with and build on their strengths.
