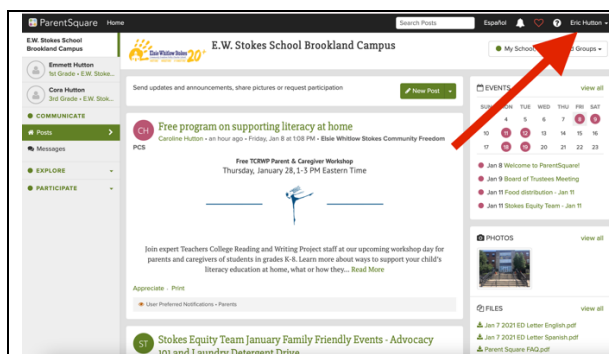


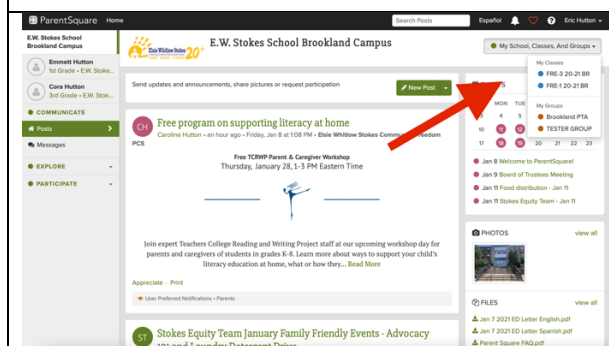
Navigating ParentSquare

- ➔ If you have trouble logging in or your link has expired, please contact Caroline Hutton CarolineH@ewstokes.org to receive a new invitation.



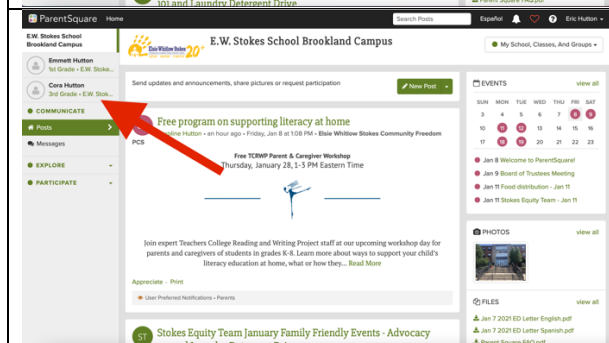
Click on your name.

- View contact information. Click to make it visible to others or hide. Click EDIT to make updates. *Notification of your update will be sent so that we can update records.*
- View your children and their classes.
- View groups that you are part of.
- Click “Notification Settings” to adjust how you receive updates. Via email (instant or digest), text, or app. ***If you choose to receive digest, you will still receive time-sensitive updates promptly.***



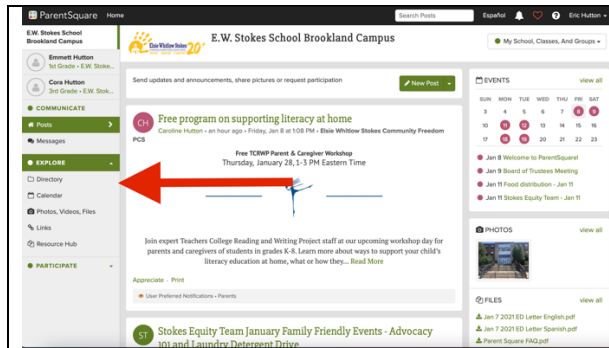
On the home page, click “My school, classes, and groups” to navigate to your class.

- In the left bar, you can view the class roster and other resources.
- In groups, you can view the group directory and any posts.



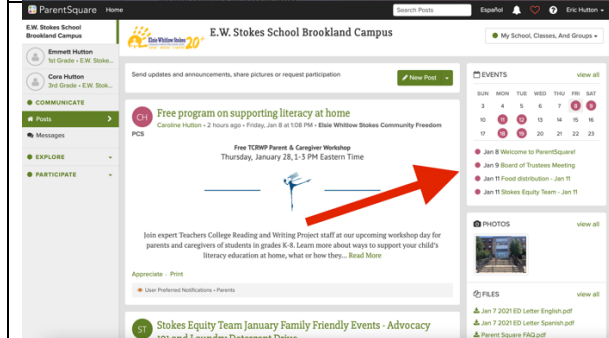
On the home page, click on your students.

- View student information and associated adults (parents/guardians).
- View their teachers.



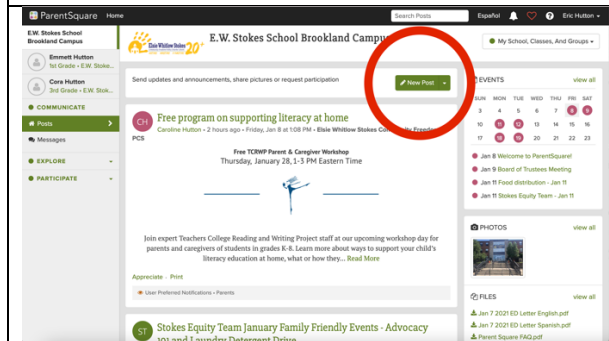
On the home page, on the left bar, expand the “Explore” tab.

- View other grade directories.
- View all-school calendar, photos, files, and links.



On the home page, the right bar is a quick access to frequent resources.

- The calendar is filled in with major school events, and other events will be added as they come up. Click on the event title for information and Zoom links (when applicable).
- Click on “view all” for a month view and options to subscribe to the calendar. *We will continue to maintain the existing Google school calendar, but for security reasons, we will not add Zoom links there.*



From the home page, create a post.

- The post creator looks and functions like a web-based form or email.
- Users cannot post to the whole school.
- Users can post to their class group and other groups they elect to join.
